
What is GlobalMinds?





Program Structure:

CaseCraft:

- Duration: 14 weeks, including 9 mentoring sessions, 3 writing coach sessions, and 2 portfolio creation sessions.
- Format: Virtual meetings via Google Meet.
- Focus: Developing a comprehensive case study in the student's field of interest, with sessions dedicated to research, writing, and portfolio creation.

GrantMaster:

- Duration: 12 weeks, including 6 mentoring sessions, 4 sessions with a grant writer, and 2 sessions for portfolio creation.
- Format: Virtual meetings via Google Meet.
- Focus: Developing a detailed grant proposal, from initial idea conception to final draft, with hands-on guidance from industry experts.



● Program Curriculum

CaseCraft Curriculum:

Week 1-2: Introduction, Research Planning, and Topic Selection.

Week 3-4: Data Collection & Analysis.

Week 5-6: Writing the Case Study (with Writing Coach).

Week 7-8: In-Depth Analysis & Drafting.

Week 9-10: Finalizing the Case Study (with Writing Coach).

Week 11-12: Presentation Preparation.

Week 13-14: Portfolio Creation & Enhancement.

GrantMaster Curriculum:

Week 1-2: Introduction, Project Planning, and Research.

Week 3-4: Writing the Grant Proposal (with Grant Writer).

Week 5-6: Refining the Grant Proposal.

Week 7-8: Finalizing the Grant Proposal (with Grant Writer).

Week 9-10: Presentation Preparation.

Week 11-12: Portfolio Creation & Enhancement.



● Program Features

- One-on-one guidance from industry professionals and subject matter experts tailored to the student's field of interest.
- Structured support with weekly sessions that guide students step-by-step through research, writing, and portfolio building
- Customized feedback and resources, ensuring each student's project is unique and reflective of their personal academic and career goals.



● Program Fee - CaseCraft

- Duration: 14 weeks
- Number of Sessions:
 - 9 individual sessions with a mentor
 - 3 sessions with a writing coach
 - 2 sessions for portfolio creation and enhancement
- Session Format: Virtual meetings via Google Meet
- Total Fee: USD 1900

● Program Fee - GrantMaster

- Duration: 12 weeks
- Number of Sessions:
 - 6 sessions with a subject matter expert (SME)/mentor
 - 4 sessions with a grant writing coach
 - 2 sessions for portfolio creation and enhancement
- Session Format: Virtual meetings via Google Meet
- Total Fee: USD 1700



● How to Apply for GlobalMinds Programs

We've made it simple for students to apply to our CaseCraft and GrantMaster programs. Follow the steps below to begin your mentorship journey:

Step 1: Submit the Application Form

- Click on the Apply Now button on the website or use the link provided in the brochure.
- Complete the form by selecting which program you are applying for (CaseCraft or GrantMaster).
- Submit the form and our team will review your information.

Step 2: Initial Consultation


- After submitting the form, our team will contact you within 48 hours to arrange a 20-minute consultation.
- This session is designed to answer any questions you may have about the program, the process, or the mentorship experience.

Step 3: Personal Essay Submission

- If you choose to move forward with the program after the consultation, you will be asked to write a short essay about yourself.
- Explain which program you're interested in.
- Share your initial ideas or goals for the project you wish to pursue.

Step 4: Mentor Matching

- Our team will carefully review your essay and match you with a mentor based on your interests, field of study, and project ideas.
- Once matched, you will be contacted with the next steps, and your program will officially begin!
