A general checklist to help students prepare before applying for financial aid

Before You Start

- Understand what financial aid is (grants, scholarships, loans, work-study)
- Know which colleges you're applying to
- Check each college's financial aid deadlines
- Create a folder (digital or physical) for aid documents

Documents to Gather

- Social Security Number (if applicable)
- Parent(s) Social Security Number (if applicable)
- Driver's license number (if you have one)
- Alien Registration Number (for eligible non-citizens)

- Federal tax returns (student + parents)
- W-2 forms and income records
- Bank statements
- Records of investments (if any)

FSA ID Setup

- Create an **FSA ID** (student)
- Create an **FSA ID** (parent/guardian)
- Save login details securely

FAFSA Application

- Complete the FAFSA form
- Enter personal and family information carefully
- List all colleges you're applying to

- Review answers before submitting
- Submit FAFSA before priority deadlines

After Submitting FAFSA

- Confirm FAFSA submission
- Check email for confirmation or follow-up requests
- Review Student Aid Report (SAR)
- Correct any errors if needed

College-Specific Aid Steps

- Check if your colleges require the **CSS Profile**
- Submit any additional financial aid forms
- Upload requested documents to college portals

Understanding Your Aid Offers

- Review financial aid award letters
- Compare grants vs loans
- Understand total cost vs net cost
- Ask questions if anything is unclear

Important Reminders

- FAFSA must be completed **every year**
- Deadlines vary by college and state
- Financial aid is not automatic—you must apply
